

June Deal Memorial Scholarship

Minimum Eligibility Requirements

Applicants must be a resident of Elkhart County for a minimum of one year and be ready to pursue a 4-year bachelor's degree at an accredited college or university. If selected for this scholarship you can reapply in the future.

Per the wishes of the original donor, priority for the scholarship will be given to a first-generation college student whose parents (biological parents, adoptive parents, or legal guardians) have not attained an advanced degree; (associate degree or higher). Traditional (HS Senior) and non-traditional (Adult) students are eligible to apply.

Selection Criteria

Selection will be based on participation in Trinity on Jackson activities, academic achievement, and the required essay. Priority will be given to graduating high school seniors.

Holcomb Family Scholarship

Minimum Eligibility Requirements

Applicants must be a High School Senior who is a resident of Elkhart County for a minimum of one year who is planning to pursue postsecondary education at an accredited two or four-year college or university. If selected for this scholarship you can reapply in the future.

Selection Criteria

Selection will be based on participation in Trinity on Jackson activities, academic achievement, demonstrated financial need, and the required essay. Priority will be given to graduating high school seniors.

Jeffrey Poorbaugh Memorial Scholarship

Minimum Eligibility Requirements

Applicants must be a High School Senior who is a resident of Elkhart County for a minimum of one year who is planning to pursue postsecondary education part or full-time at an accredited two or four-year college or university.

Preferred Fields of Study include STEM curricula such as: Electrical Engineering, Trade/Vocational School study of Electronics, Computer Technology, Math or Science. If selected for this scholarship you can reapply in the future.

Selection Criteria

Selection will be based on participation in Trinity on Jackson activities, academic achievement, and the required essay. Priority will be given to graduating high school seniors.

The Completed application is due by Wednesday, May 3, 2023, at 12:00 PM, in the Trinity on Jackson office. If electronically submitted, please verify the submission by emailing michelle.hartwig@trinityonjackson.org.

ALL applications must include the following documents:

- 1. **Essay** (1 page maximum, double spaced) addressing your involvement with Trinity on Jackson youth programs and why it was important to you.
- 2. One **photograph** of yourself (will not be returned) to be used in internal and external promotion and publicity if you are a scholarship recipient.
- 3. A copy of your **most recent transcript**.

For <u>Deal</u> Scholarship and <u>Poorbaugh</u> applications:

Additional Essay: A1 page maximum, double spaced) describing your aspirations and educational goals.

Non-traditional Applicants: Must provide their most recent college or high school transcript or a letter of recommendation from a relevant professional.

For <u>Holcomb</u> Scholarship applications:

A Copy of your **Estimated Family Contribution from the FASFA**.
