Founded in 1952 by members of the church, the Trinity Foundation carefully invests financial gifts given to the church. These gifts are then used to support or fully fund projects, programs, and scholarships as well as fund maintenance needs at our church building. Here is our year-end report.

Trinity Foundation 2025 Grants

- Continued our support of a Trinity member at seminary.
- Gave a \$1,000 grant to “Girls on the Run,” a community wide program supporting upper elementary and middle school girls. Several Trinity members are active in this program.
- Provided financial support for Creative Arts Camp.
- Hosted a rededication of the church bell after the completion of repairs.
- Provided scholarships for Barkley Basketball.
- Assisted Trinity in covering 2024 budget shortfall.
- Granted 15 college scholarships.
- Gave our second annual grant to the Pre-School to help cover scholarships and supplies.
- Paid for the Pre-School staff to attend Conference at IUSB
- Funded the purchase of equipment and furnishings for the volunteer quarters at the Bonsai After School Program in Ecuador
- Paid the fees for the Owls Club to join the Neighbor Link program.
- Replaced the kitchen HVAC system at the church building.
- Replaced several air conditioners at the church building.
- Granted Education Grants to two Trinity volunteers to complete college degrees.
- Replaced shrubs at the parsonage.

Those of us on the Foundation board like to have grant requests on the agendas of every meeting. We want to ensure that the money with which we have been entrusted, is used regularly and often throughout the year so that we can continue to be the Heart of Jesus in the Heart of Elkhart!
